Policy Adopted at September 13, 1999 Board Meeting

## CHEMICAL PEELS

### MANUFACTURERS:

1. Products offered for sale to estheticians and cosmetologists must meet the June 6, 1997 Cosmetic Ingredient Review (CIR) for "Glycolic Acid; Ammonium, Calcium, Potassium and Sodium Glycolate; Methyl, Ethyl, Propyl, and Butyl Glycolate; Lactic Acid; Ammonium, Calcium, Potassium, Sodium, and TEA-Lactate; and, Lauryl, Myristyl, and Cetyl Lactate. Ingredient concentrations are to be 30% or less at final formulation with pH not to be less than 3.0.
2. Products must be sold to licensed salons or schools only in prepackaged materials.
3. Must provide the State Board with a copy of their training materials and certification process in order to sell to licensed cosmetologists and estheticians.
4. Must provide the names and listings of all products to be sold.
5. Must provide a customer list of salons using equipment and record of training provided by individual name on a quarterly basis on the 15th of January, April, July and October.

### LICENSEES:

1. Must prominently display the manufacturer's certificate of training for each type of service provided with their state license.
2. Must follow the guidelines of The Esthetics Manufacturers and Distributors Alliance of the American Beauty Association pamphlet "Professional Guidelines for Alphahydroxy Acid Cosmetic Chemical Exfoliation Procedures".
3. Must comply with manufacturers' directions in the use of each product.
4. Must advise clients of the necessity of sunscreen protection following procedure.

## MICRODERMABRASION

### MANUFACTURERS:

1. Products must be sold to licensed salons and schools only.
2. Must provide the State Board with a copy of their training materials and certification process in order to sell to licensed cosmetologists and estheticians.
3. Must provide the names and listings of all products to be sold.
4. Must provide a customer list of salons using equipment and record of training provided by individual name on a quarterly basis on the 15th of January, April, July and October.

### LICENSEES: \*\*

1. Must prominently display the manufacturer's certificate of training for each type of equipment used with their state license.
2. Must comply with manufacturers' directions in the use of each product.
3. Must advise clients of the necessity of sunscreen protection following procedure.
