

Barber Supply List Information

Labeling Requirements

Disinfectant/Sanitizer:

Manufacturer's label are required on all disinfectants, hand sanitizers, and liquid hand soap. Labels must be original or photocopied originals. (Hand written or typed labels are not acceptable)

Supplies/Products:

All exam supplies and products are required to be labeled in English as to the content. Hand written labels may be used.

Equipment: Labeling is not required.

Supply List Items

Adjustable clippers – Must be good working order and have not been modified from the manufacturer's specifications. Students are permitted to bring multiple clippers. However, if a student brings a clipper with detachable blades, each clipper brought must have the same detachable blade size.

Outliners/trimmers - Must be in good working order and have not been modified in any manner from the manufacturer's specifications.

Shears – Must be in good working order. Shears with broken/damaged blades are not permitted.

Blow Dryer – Must be in good working order.

Combs – Must be free of hair, dirt, and debris. All purpose, flattop, taper, and hair pick.

Shaving Mug/Shaving Brush/Shaving Soap – Shaving mug and brush must be clean. Shaving soap must be clean and in a closed container (Ziploc bag) labeled as shaving soap (if shaving soap is in the shaving mug, place mug and soap in container and label).

Spray bottle – Must be clean and unfilled, students will be permitted to fill bottles during set up.

Chair Cloth (drape)/Cloth Clip – chair cloth must clean and free of hair, dirt, and debris.

Neck strips – A full package or the number of neck strips a student deems necessary to complete procedures. All neck strips should be in a closed container (Ziploc bag) and labeled as "neck strips".

Brushes – Must be free of hair, dirt, and debris.

Spatula – Must be clean.

Cloth Towels – Must be clean, placed in plastic bag (may use a small new unused trash bag) labeled "cloth towels"

Paper linen i.e. PST towels or Wubbies – A full package or the number of towels a student deems necessary to complete procedures. All paper products should be stored in a closed container (Ziploc bag) and labeled.

Facial Creams – Enough product for one (1) facial service is needed. Products should be placed in a closed container.

- One (1) container of rolling cream product
- One (1) container of massage cream product.

Any small container with lid is acceptable. (EX: solo salad dressing cup with lid)

Cotton – cotton balls, pledgets, cotton swabs, strips from a roll. Place in closed container (Ziploc bag). Suggested number of cotton items 5-10.

Astringent – May be placed in travel size container or other small container and label.

Note: Students may bring the astringent in the original bottle.

Styptic – One small bottle or container.

Talcum Powder - One small bottle or container.

Shampoo/Conditioner – Enough for one (1) shampoo service and one (1) conditioning service.

Any small container with lid is acceptable.

Liquid Hand Soap – a small bottle or container.

Trash Bag liners (3) – small plastic trash can liners.

Disinfectant – Must have original manufacturer's label or a photocopied original label attached. Examples of disinfectants are: Mar-v-Cide, Barbicide, Barbicide Wipes, Barbicide Plus, Citrus II, and Lucascide.

First Aid Supplies (blood spill kit) – This kit may be assembled with the following items:

- Band-Aids or bandages
- Astringent or antiseptic.
- Disposable gloves
- Sealable plastic storage bags (1-2 bags) for bagging contaminated items.

First aid supplies will need to be used if a student and/or model sustains a cut causing a blood spill.

All first aid supplies may be placed in a sealable container (Ziploc bag) and labeled "First Aid".

NOTE: This first aid kit does not need to be a commercial first aid kit.
