Acting under the authority of the Ohio Revised Code Sections 119.03, the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board hereby announces a public hearing will be held Monday, May 13, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. in the Board Room, 1929 Gateway Circle, Grove City, Ohio. This is a statement of the agency's intention to promulgate the following rules:

Amended Rules

- **4713-3-04: Additional campus facilities.**
Purpose: The rule language is not being amended. The rule is being amended to update the authority and amplification by referencing applicable provisions under ORC 4709.
- **4713-7-02: No communication between applicants during examination.**
Purpose: The rule language is not being amended. The rule is being amended to update the authority and amplification by referencing applicable provisions under ORC 4709.
- **4713-21-06: Applying for inactive licensure status and temporary work permit.**
Purpose: The rule is being amended to correct paragraph (B) of the rule. The current version references paragraph (A) (14) of rule 4713-1-17 of the Administrative Code. This citation is being corrected to reference paragraph (N) of rule 4713-1-17 of the Administrative Code.
